VINEYARD

Valdelac comes from selected vineyards located on the Rotaliana plain (Teroldego) and in the Adige Valley (Schiava). It is made from a blend of two different grape varieties, Teroldego and Schiava. Schiava is an indigenous variety in the Trentino-Alto Adige region, cultivated since time immemorial and mentioned as early as 1300. Teroldego is the premium characteristic indigenous variety of the province of Trento, cultivated on the Rotaliano Plain and for which written records exist from the 15th century onwards.

VINIFICATION

After a careful selection has been made in the vineyard, the grapes spend a short time in contact with the skins in the press before being crushed; temperature-controlled fermentation follows. The wine is then left to develop in stainless steel to preserve its fragrance and freshness, before cold bottling.
